- Motions for By-laws, Regulations, or Standing Rules must be written on the form provided (available on the web site or from the office) and submitted to the Executive Director a minimum of sixty (60) days prior to the Annual General Meeting of the Members. Motions not received by these deadlines will be dealt with at a subsequent meeting, unless they are urgent in nature, in which case, the Board of Directors may elect to waive the notification period.
- All motions shall be moved and seconded by either a voting Delegate or a member of the OFSAA Board of Directors.
- Motions for Playing Regulations must be written on the form provided (available on the web site or from the office) and submitted to the Executive Director by October 15th for the fall Representatives' Council meeting, and February 15th prior to the spring Representatives' Council meeting. Motions not received by these deadlines will be dealt with at a subsequent meeting, unless they are urgent in nature, in which case, the Board of Directors may elect to waive the notification period.
- All motions shall be moved and seconded by the Sport Advisory Committee, teachers (current or retired), school administrator, members of the Representatives Council, or a member of the OFSAA Board of Directors.
